Dues and fees: Annual membership dues for 2012 will stay the same as last year (\$650). A small assessment may be required later this year if our membership numbers do not increase. Dues are owed by May 15, 2012. **Cabin taxes** also remain at \$125 and are due by August 15, 2012. Costs for **propane tanks** remain at \$95; Missed work weekends are \$40 and guest fees remain at \$10 and \$5 (winter). All fees are due within 30 days from the date first incurred; a 10% per-month late fee is owed to the club thereafter.

Calendars: 2012 Robinwood calendars are available. Please let me know if you would like one (or more), mailed to you or dropped off at your cabin. You can send me a donation (min of \$10) to cover material and mailing or include additional dollars that will go towards trout stocking.

Club cabins: Note that AC power lines, outlets, and lights are available in each cabin (if you wish to bring your own generator).

Events: The tentative date for Spring work weekend is Saturday May 12th; the annual club picnic is Sat July 28th;

and Fall Work weekend is Saturday September 8th, 2011. The board voted to fix the future-event dates for spring work weekend as the second Saturday in May; the club picnic as the last Saturday in July, and fall work weekend as the second Saturday in September.

Firewood: No live trees may be cut anywhere on the Lyme lease - between the main gate and the lakes without Al's OK. Dead trees or those knocked over along the road may be cut on our property (Sabattis LLC - beyond the lakes). No firewood may be brought onto or off of the lease to reduce the movement of invasive insects harmful to local forests.

ATVs, boats, parking, fishing and hunting: Please note that all ATVs and boats need to be registered, helmets are required for all ATV riders, ATVs have to be licensed and insured, PFDs have to be used while on the water, absolutely no parking is permitted on state land, and no motors are permitted in Lows Lake.
